The focus of this newsletter for this month (December) is on two of our precious children and their daily life at Asha Kuteer. They are Sekhar and Sravanthi who are siblings aged 10 and 7 years respectively. We have included before and after photographs so you can see how their physical/emotional development has positively progressed. There are also tables for you to properly gauge where the children are situated with their literacy/numeracy/language developmental progress and how far they have come!

The story of Sekhar and Sravanthi.

As we mentioned earlier, Sekhar and Sravanthi are siblings from a family that tells a tragic tale. The children witnessed their Father killing their Mother in a most cruel and violent manner. This, on its own is a devastation that no child should bear. Then, in another act of cruelty, their Father also died under suspicious circumstances. This led Sekhar and Sravanthi to be under the care of their Grandmother, who was unable to take care of them who brought the children to Asha Kuteer. We consider it a great honour and privilege to care for these precious children and to make a difference in their lives.

Developmental progress of the children.

Physical/Health/Movement skills progress:

Before Sekhar and Sravanthi came into Asha Kuteer's care, their physical wellness was quite poor. Both children were underweight and lacked motivation to

participate in any kind of physical activity or "play". Nowadays however, after just a few months, it is difficult to keep the children sitting still! Sekhar and Sravanthi very much enjoy running, skipping, jumping and playing with their Asha Kuteer family and friends during their leisure time. This change is easily seen from the children's before and after pictures.

Social and Emotional development progress:

As you can probably imagine, considering the children's previous home life, this area of development was in serious lack for both Sekhar and Sravanthi. On arrival to Asha Kuteer, both children were very shy, reserved and reluctant to give, receive or show love. It was normal for them to cast their eyes down to the ground and be unsmiling. After many weeks of receiving the help Sekhar and Sravanthi needed in this particular area, we are so proud of their positive progress! The children have overcome many obstacles and accomplished great milestones that they are still continuing to master each and every day. As you can depict from the photographs, smiling is very easy for them now. These precious hearts also love to give and receive hugs from their family members.

Learning development:

We are also very proud of the children's academic progress over the past months as it has improved dramatically. Included in this newsletter are many examples in table form of Sekhar and Sravanthi's academic progress. Please look at them at your leisure. It is very easy to see from the tables the advancements of the children's learning. Their test scores have greatly improved in all areas of Mathematics and English medium which is a true credit to their conscientious attitude to their school work. Sekhar and Sravanthi just love going to school!

So as you can see Sekhar and Sravanthi are progressing extraordinarily well in all aspect of their development. Thank you so much for providing the means for us
